 U16 Elite Boys Lead Coach from 2020 to 2021, and U17 and U19 Elite Boys Assistant Coach from 2020 to 2022
- Performed an active role in the progression of players who joined MLS clubs, including FC Dallas, Inter Miami, Orlando City, Columbus Crew and St Louis City
- Various players from the 2006, 2007, 2008 and 2009 age groups were identified for US Soccer Talent ID Centres and for MLS and European trials
- Multiple players within older age groups have progressed to collegiate soccer, including NCAA D1 schools such
 as Duke, UNC, Kentucky, Clemson and Notre Dame

Performance Analysis

- Led a department of seven Assistant Coaches, who were all promoted to Head Coach roles over an 18-month period
- Designed and delivered a physical data collection process throughout the age-group squads in the Academy
- Implemented performance insights and an injury prevention monitoring system for players and coaches
- Introduced a performance analysis process designed to support player education and engagement for all coaches and teams, including a video library of professional and youth games
- Forged relationships and worked in conjunction with leading sporting partners, including Playermaker, Statsports, Hudl, Spiideo, Kitman Labs, Smartabase, Metrica Sports, Coach Paint, Keyframe and Sport Session Planner

Curriculum & Methodology

- Instrumental in the development, design and implementation of an evolved IMG Performance Plan (Game Model)
- The IMG Performance Plan incorporated age-specific development plans and key concepts for each age group, with emphasis on age-appropriate activities and individual plans
- The IMG Performance Plan has been adopted by all MLS Next, Girls Academy and USYS teams within the Academy

Individual Development Plans (IDP)

- Perform a key role in the enhancement of IDP processes across Academy operations
- Introduced a strategy which prioritises individual coach-player relationships, with increased time allocated to one-to-one sessions within daily and weekly schedules
- Instrumental in modernising IDP reporting by integrating media platforms and data sources into a template; ensured subjective and objective points were made available to players for reference

Athletic & Personal Development Integration (APD)

- Liaise with and work in conjunction with the interdisciplinary team, which comprises sports scientists, strength and conditioning coaches, mental performance coaches, and nutrition and leadership coaches
- Forge relationships with coaches, players, families, school administrators and youth sport leaders on local, national and international levels to enhance the sporting experience for IMG student-athletes and coaches
- Worked with various departments to formulate a process that ensured player education within each area was aligned with the methodology and age-appropriate framework for all players
